



COVID-19 GUIDELINES FOR ATTENDING ACCELERATE 21

The Minnesota Credit Union Network is committed to the wellbeing of all attendees, guests, sponsors, speakers, and staff as we return to in person events.

To help maintain safety at our events, we are implementing a “health attestation” policy for all attendees, exhibitors, speakers and staff. **This means when a person attends ACCELERATE 21, they are attesting that, to the best of their knowledge, neither they nor any member of their household, are experiencing any of the CDC-defined COVID-19 symptoms.** Below are the current symptoms to monitor, though the list may change if the CDC announces new symptom guidance.

- Fever above 100.4 degrees
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Chills or repeated shaking with chills
- Muscle pain
- Headache
- Sore throat
- New loss of taste or smell

In addition, MnCUN will be implementing the guidelines below:

- MnCUN staff will be wearing masks.
- All exhibiting partners will be required to wear masks while in the tradeshow.
- All attendees are encouraged to wear masks while participating in the event. Masks will be readily available for attendees.
- Frequent hand washing is encouraged, and hand sanitizer will be available throughout the event.
- We are working with the venue to ensure a hyper-focus on cleanliness, health and safety, and offering food service in a safe manner to minimize attendee touchpoints.
- The conference room and tradeshow layouts have been updated from previous years to allow for additional social distancing.
- MnCUN will share updates and announcements during the event via the conference app.

By attending MnCUN’s ACCELERATE 21, participants assume all risks related to the exposure to COVID-19. Staff will continue to monitor the situation leading up to and at the event, and communicate any changes. Thank you for your flexibility and commitment to keeping yourself and others healthy.
